From the South leave the A1 at the junction with the A64 and proceed towards York turning left at the A1036, the hotel is situated on the left within walking distance of the town centre.

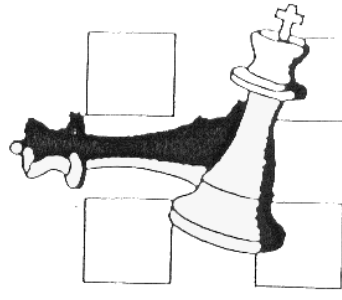
From the North (A19) turn right at the ring road, then left at Holgate road (A59). At the end of the road turn right into The Mount, the hotel is on the right.

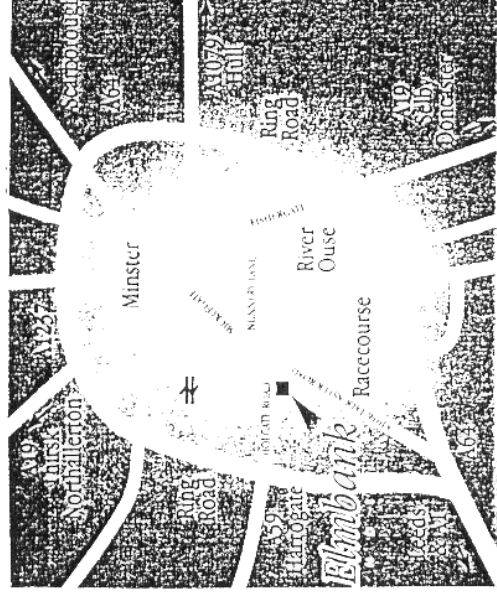

2. Ages are calculated as at midnight on 31 August 2001. Players must play in their own age group, except at the discretion of the organisers.

4. Players arriving more than 30 minutes late will be deemed to have lost by default, except at the control team's discretion. Players whose opponents have not arrived by that time may be re-paired.
